

**Monitoring and Evaluation Officer  
Bioko Island Malaria Control Program (BIMCP)**

The Bioko Island Malaria Control Project (BIMCP), funded by Marathon Oil Company and the Government of Equatorial Guinea, seeks to substantially reduce morbidity and mortality caused by malaria on Bioko Island. BIMCP's interventions are centered on indoor residual spraying, distribution of long-lasting insecticide-treated mosquito nets, case management, and monitoring and evaluation. The project has begun a second five-year phase, which includes a substantial investment in human resources development and a strong commitment to capacity-building and integration. The objective will be to prepare the Ministry of Health and Social Welfare in Equatorial Guinea to assume full responsibility for the management of the BIMCP's malaria control activities. MCDI implements the BIMCP together with partner organizations including Yale University, Texas A&M University's AgriLife Research, and the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine (LSHTM).

**Qualifications, Skills and Experience required:**

- Graduate degree in Public Health or Epidemiology
- Established track record in monitoring and evaluation of health programs, preferably malaria control, in a developing country setting
- Good interpersonal skills, team player, able to work under stress. Sensitivity to the concerns of the developing world and able to work with local and national authorities and community-based providers from different cultural backgrounds.
- Substantial experience with data analysis, technical report writing, scientific publications. Experience in producing articles for peer-reviewed journals.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills in Spanish with knowledge of English and/or French an additional asset.
- Highly computer literate, familiar with Windows® programs for word-processing, spreadsheets, database management, statistical analysis, presentations, and electronic communication.

**Overview of Position:**

The Monitoring and Evaluation Officer (M&EO) is responsible for the development, implementation, technical backstopping and coordination of MCDI's monitoring and evaluation activities for the BIMCP.

**The specific responsibilities of the M&EO include, inter alia:**

- Assume overall responsibility for the management of in-country BIMCP monitoring and evaluation activities, liaising closely with the National Malaria Control Program (NMCP) to include most specifically the new M&E counterpart, as well as the MOH's Monitoring and Evaluation Officer, staff from the National Health Information System, and other relevant officials and departments within the MOH.
- With assistance from the home office, organize and implement the annual parasitemia survey to include training of enumerators, coordination and supervision of field work, review of data quality etc.

- Supervise and reinforce the Malaria Information System (MIS), ensuring that data from patient registers are being compiled and processed in a routine, accurate and timely fashion.
- Provide supervisory oversight and technical support to BIMCP staffs in maintaining the Malaria Inventory and Supervision Module (MISM).
- During indoor residual spraying (IRS) rounds, ensure that IRS data are being gathered correctly using the PDA application developed for this purpose, and that data are downloaded and consolidated in a timely and correct manner.
- Participating in Operations Research: design, data collection, data analysis, writing reports. Examples of OR may include: how are innovative approaches (GIS-malaria risk mapping, entomological and epidemiological surveys) and routine data used in improving program management, working closely with the MOH.
- Supervise and provide technical assistance to all entomological surveillance activities, ensuring that these activities are well coordinated with other BIMCP monitoring and evaluation activities and that they are being carried out in an accurate and timely manner.
- Assist in developing and regularly monitoring and updating the BIMCP work plan with specific reference to the M&E component in collaboration with the BIMCP COP and the BIMCP Project Manager. Assist in the preparation of progress and other reports as required.
- Mentor and provide on-the-job training to the new M&E counterpart from the NMCP.
- Participate in the preparation of new technical proposals, as necessary.
